How do I know what and who to report?

<http://www.vesid.nysed.gov/sedcar/sppschedule.html> - will tell you which Federal Indicator data you as a district are responsible for reporting this year.

Report any student who was referred for Special Ed services whose "key event" took place during the 09-10 school year.

What are the "key events" to determine whether you need to report an event chain?

- o For the CPSE chain: date of receipt of parent consent to evaluate the preschool child
- o For the CSE chain: date of receipt of parent consent to evaluate the school age student
- o For the EI chain: date of receipt of initial referral from Early Intervention (EI) to CPSE
- o For the CSENP chain: date of receipt of initial referral to CSE of a school-age student parentally placed in an elementary or secondary non-public school


What if the key event happens at the end of the 09-10 school year and subsequent events in a chain occur in the 10-11 school year? I thought Level 0 couldn't cross years?


If any of the key events, mentioned above, occur between July 1, 2009 and June 30, 2010, the student and complete event chain must be reported in the 09-10 reporting year. Your Special Ed system is set up to record this data across two school years, if necessary. The complete chain, including any events that may take place in the 10-11 school year, will be reported as S.E. Event Data in Level 0 for the 09-10 school year.

What if the key event happens after June 30, 2010?

You don't report them in this year's (09-10) S.E. Event Data.

TEMPLATE TIDBITS

The **Green Plus**  lets you add a new link in the chain.

The **Red X**  lets you delete a link in the chain. However, you can only delete the last link. It won't let you delete a middle link.
